Clothing not only protects us from the elements, it helps shape our confidence, dignity and motivation. And that has the power to turn lives around.



Thread Together was born from the belief that access to clothing could create brighter futures for those doing it tough.

Founded in 2012, we have been dedicated to collaborating with some of Australia's largest clothing suppliers and social service agencies to change the clothes and futures of people in crisis.

We're committed to making a difference to the homeless,

victims of domestic violence, asylum seekers, indigenous communities, ex-inmates, and other vulnerable groups in the community.

We believe that disadvantage should not prevent people in our community from realising their potential. As well as providing the clothes that can change how people are perceived, the personal support that we provide restores optimism, confidence and self-esteem.

Our model is very simple. We collect end-of-line brand new stock from clothing providers. With the support of volunteers, the clothes are sorted by age, gender, and purpose, and then re-distributed to people in need through charities across Australia. I think of it as redistributive justice.

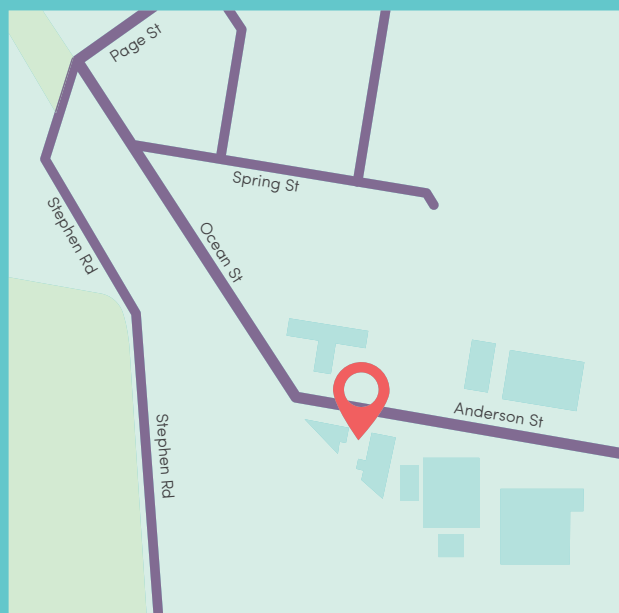
